

Climate Educator in Residence 2026-27 Position Description

The Institute for Global Learning Climate Educator-in-Residence position provides leaders from within our community the opportunity to collaborate alongside our staff in support of our mission. The educator is able to further develop their own leadership within the field of global education with special attention to climate education and sustainability leadership.

In recognition of the efforts of the Climate Educator-in-Residence, the Institute for Global Learning is able to provide a \$1,000 stipend for the one-year residence, requiring approximately 1-2 hours of time per week, on average.

While the specific nature of the role is defined by the interests and skills of the educator, the role *may* involve the following opportunities and responsibilities, as the individual's interests and schedule allow:

- Provide feedback and insight to support program offerings, research and publications, benchmarking data collection, event content and design, and communications—including being a member of the Climate Committee and meeting approximately twice a month with a member of the Institute for Global Learning staff
- Attend, present at, and/or help facilitate during the Climate Education Summit
- Serve as the lead facilitator for our monthly Climate Educator Meet-Up
- Serve as the host of 2-4 topical meet-ups and/or webinars throughout the year
- Write an article for the our blog, *The Exchange*, or our Annual Magazine, *Interconnected*
- Engage in the life of the organization as it relates to the educator's professional/personal interests

We are looking for individuals with a passion for our mission and work as well as experience in the field of climate education in a K-12 context. The specific schedule of commitments will be largely determined by the educator, and the residence will begin with an inventory of the educator's interests and further narrowing of the role's opportunities and responsibilities.

The 2026-27 Climate Educator-in-Residence will begin in September 2026 and conclude in July 2027.

Applicants should submit a letter of interest highlighting the skills and experiences they would bring to the role and their specific areas of interest, in addition to a current CV. The deadline to submit materials is Friday, August 28, 2026.
