

Global Educator in Residence 2026-27 Position Description

The Institute for Global Learning Global Educator-in-Residence position provides leaders from within our community the opportunity to collaborate alongside our staff in support of our mission. The educator is able to further develop their own leadership within the field of global education with special attention to climate education and sustainability leadership.

In recognition of the efforts of the Global Educator-in-Residence, the Institute for Global Learning is able to provide a \$1,000 stipend for the one-year residence, requiring approximately 1-2 hours of time per week, on average.

While the specific nature of the role is defined by the interests and skills of the educator, the role *may* involve the following opportunities and responsibilities, as the individual's interests and schedule allow:

- Provide feedback and insight to support Institute program offerings, research and publications, benchmarking data collection, event content and design, and communications, meeting approximately twice a month with a member of the Institute for Global Learning Staff
- Attend, present at, and/or facilitate during the Annual Conference
- Serve as an evaluator for GEBG School Endorsements and/or Evaluations (involves virtual or in-person school visit and report-writing)
- Write an article for the Blog, *The Exchange*, or the Institute for Global Learning's annual magazine, *Interconnected*
- Engage in the life of the organization as it relates to the educator's professional/personal interests

We are looking for individuals with a passion for the Institute for Global Learning's mission and work and experience in global education in a K-12 context. The educator will largely determine the specific schedule of commitments, and the residence will begin with an inventory of the educator's interests and further narrowing of the role's opportunities and responsibilities.

The 2026-27 Educator-in-Residence will begin in September 2026 and conclude in July 2027.

Applicants should submit a letter of interest highlighting the skills and experiences they would bring to the role and their specific areas of interest, in addition to a current CV. The deadline to submit materials is Friday, August 28, 2026.
